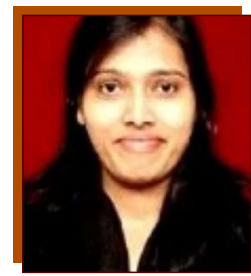

Guidelines for Minija Joseph Awards 2026

- ▶ This award will be given to an individual. It is not meant for any specific organization or institution.
- ▶ Perioperative nurses in India are invited to compete by submitting a summary of the work they have been involved with in the past 12 months to improve patient safety in the operation theatre.
- ▶ This can be presented as a new innovation, a project or an education, which meets this purpose.
- ▶ The submission must be in English and be an accurate note from the individual's endeavour to achieve a safe and successful outcome for patients.
- ▶ The submission must be validated by the applicant and the Theatre Senior Manager/Chief Nursing Officer /Nursing Director, who may be contacted by a member of the Judging committee in the future.
- ▶ The application form should be submitted by 1st Sept 2026.
- ▶ Registration of the applicant in the conference 2026 is mandatory.
- ▶ Only registered members of SPN are eligible for this award.

- ▶ Word limit: 800 words and should not exceed this.
- ▶ Keep it simple, share your personal experience and that of your team.

- ▶ Refer to researched articles, but do not focus there. Your submission should be based on your own working experience; clearly, we want to understand what you have done and are doing in your own workplace.
- ▶ Please complete all paperwork details as requested. Unfortunately, if there are gaps in what is required, this will render your application form submission invalid.

ORAL PRESENTATION

Guidelines for Abstract Submission:

- ▶ Participation is open to all categories of nursing personnel and students.
- ▶ The presenting author has to be physically present.
- ▶ Topics should be related to the perioperative care.
- ▶ Abstracts must be original and should not have been submitted/presented/ intended for presentation elsewhere. Only original research will be accepted.
- ▶ The presenting author is required to ensure that the co-investigators are aware & they approve the content.
- ▶ Abstract should not exceed more than 300 words, in a Word document.
- ▶ Abstract should be prepared using “Times New Roman” font with font size 12.
- ▶ Word limit of 300 words excludes names of authors, title, key words, references, tables/figures.
- ▶ The time allotted is 8 min for presentation and 2 min for discussion.
- ▶ Abstract should be sent to workshopconaiimsngp@gmail.com by 20th August 2026.
- ▶ Acceptance of oral paper will be informed through mail by the Scientific committee.
- ▶ Last date for abstract submission: 20/08/2026

SCIENTIFIC E-POSTER

- ▶ Participation is open to all categories of nursing personnel and students.
- ▶ The poster may be based on any topic relevant to the field of nursing and is not restricted to perioperative care.
- ▶ Both offline and online participants can submit e-poster, and should be available to answer any queries from the judges.
- ▶ Language: ONLY English language.
- ▶ The title of the e-Poster should be brief.
- ▶ Author and affiliations:
Names and affiliations of all authors should be marked with superscript Arabic numbers corresponding to Institute affiliations.
- ▶ The logo of the affiliated Institution/University (if any) should be placed in the upper left-hand corner.
- ▶ File format: Use a PDF file in landscape orientation.
- ▶ Size: The poster should be one page.
- ▶ Resolution: Images and tables should be at least 300 dpi.
- ▶ Font types: Arial, Calibri, Times New Roman
- ▶ Font size: Greater than 11. Use bold for the title and subheadings, and avoid italics.
- ▶ Colours: Use minimal colours and choose background colours that contrast well with the font.
- ▶ Content: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, References
- ▶ Scientific e-poster should be sent to workshopconaiimsngp@gmail.com by 20th August 2026.
- ▶ Acceptance of scientific e-paper will be informed through mail by the Scientific committee.
- ▶ Shortlisted e-posters will be electronically displayed on the day of conference.
- ▶ Each participant will be given 2-3 minutes for questions and answers.

CASE PRESENTATION

- ▶ Participation is open to all categories of nursing personnel and students.
- ▶ The presenter has to be physically present.
- ▶ The case selected should be relevant to the conference theme.
- ▶ The best cases share three key elements: "Relevance", "Novelty" and "Scientific merit".
- ▶ Present the case clearly, concisely, and succinctly.
- ▶ Include relevant photos as desirable.
- ▶ Be sure to remove any patient identifiers (such as patient name, date of birth, etc).
- ▶ Format for presentation:
 - Slide 1: Name of presenter, Email, Institutional affiliations, WhatsApp number
 - Slide 2: Introduction: Purpose, background, objectives
 - Slide 3 & 4: Patient information: Demographics, medical history, health assessment
 - Slide 5 & 6: Case description: Clinical presentation, diagnosis findings, treatment/plan
 - Slide 7 & 8: Nursing care plan: Nursing diagnosis, goals and outcomes, interventions, evaluation
 - Slide 9: Analysis: Critical analysis & reflection
 - Slide 10: Conclusion: Summary, implications for practice, recommendation

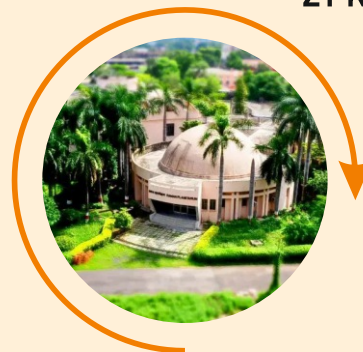
